A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1- 1 To amend Code Section 20-3-519 of the Official Code of
1- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions applicable to
1- 3 HOPE scholarships and grants, so as to change the definition
1- 4 of the term "eligible high school"; to thereby change
1- 5 conditions of eligibility for HOPE scholarships and grants;
1- 6 to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting
1- 7 laws; and for other purposes.

1- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

1- 9 SECTION 1.

1-10 Code Section 20-3-519 of the Official Code of Georgia
1-11 Annotated, relating to definitions applicable to HOPE
1-12 scholarships and grants, is amended by striking in its

1-13 entirety paragraph (6) and inserting in lieu thereof a new
1-14 paragraph (6) to read as follows:

1-15 "(6) 'Eligible high school' means a public or private
1-16 secondary school which is:

1-17 (A) Located in Georgia and accredited as such by:

1-18 (i) The Southern Association of Colleges and
1-19 Schools;

1-20 (ii) The Georgia Accrediting Commission;

1-21 (iii) The Georgia Association of Christian Schools;
1-22 ~~or~~

1-23 (iv) The Association of Christian Schools
1-24 International; or

1-25 (v) The Georgia Private School Accreditation
1-26 Council; or

1-27 (B) Located in another state and accredited by one of
1-28 the following regional agencies:

1-29 (i) The Southern Association of Colleges and
1-30 Schools;

2- 1 (ii) The New England Association of Schools and
2- 2 Colleges;

2- 3 (iii) The Middle States Association of Colleges and
2- 4 Schools;

2- 5 (iv) The North Central Association of Colleges and
2- 6 Schools;

2- 7 (v) The Northwestern Association of Schools and
2- 8 Colleges; or

2- 9 (vi) The Western Association of Schools and
2-10 Colleges."

2-11 SECTION 2.

2-12 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2000.

2-13 SECTION 3.

2-14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
2-15 repealed.
